HOUSTON (January 15, 2008) – Brussels-based VRcontext has announced the release of Walkinside® Version 5 virtual reality software.

Walkinside software has been redeveloped to deliver faster, more intuitive navigation of large complex production assets using .NET technology, which enables remote collaboration through the Internet with online virtualization tools that are accessible even from low-end workstations.
